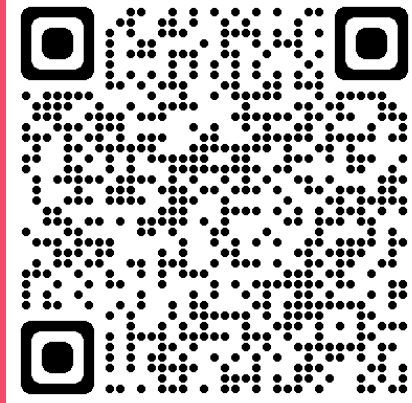
WHAT IT IS...
